

ENAP SIPETROL ARGENTINA - PIAM PROJECT





In Q3 2016 the contract was awarded for Pipelay and Construction services at the East entrance of the Magellan Strait between an onshore gas plant located at Punta Dugeness (Argentina) and the Àrea Magallanes field (AM).



Enap Sipetrol Argentina - acting in its capacity of Representative of the Union Transitoria de Empresas Magallaness - awarded a contract for pipelay and construction for its PIAM project. Water depths in the area are up to 70m.

The scope of work consisted of the installation of pipelines, risers and spools as well as the removal of three existing flexible lines and abandonment of the two pipelines to be replaced in the AM Field Development (PIAM) in Block AM, offshore Argentina.

The DP3 Telford 34 (ex Jascon 34) was selected for the work scope and transited from Batam, Indonesia, to mobilize for the PIAM (Proyecto Incremental Àrea Magallanes) project. Offshore activities started during Q4 2016.



After completion of the offshore construction campaign an accommodation services contract was awarded for the Telford 34. This additional contract from Enap Sipetrol showcases the advantage for the clients of the versatility of our DP3 safe and value-adding accommodation and construction vessels, able to work in shallow, deep or difficult waters.
